

Clammer Hill allotment – entrance

BACKGROUND

Allotment holders have requested the entrance be upgraded. The ground is very uneven and needs repair and resurfacing. There is a possibility of damage to the underneath of cars using it.

Town Hall officers obtained three quotes, all of whom recommended Tarmac over concrete.

The Amenities Committee agreed, on 15 October 2020, to proceed with this project subject to approval from Full Council as the cost is above the threshold of its delegated authority, and agreed to instruct Axtell Ltd to do the job using Tarmac.

Works required:

- Allotment holders given advance notice – access on foot via public footpath.
- Cordon off area.
- Confirm no other services involved. Water highlighted.
- Removal of old driveway by approx. 120mm to 150mm in depth
- Re levelled use existing excavated if possible, in natural slope.
- Top covering to be confirmed, possibly tarmac or concrete.
- Edging into natural grass.
- Concrete/granite edging curve on entrance
- Area approximately 60sqm
- Quote on Concrete and Tarmac options

Conclusion from all companies that have quoted is that they do not recommend concrete, they do recommend Asphalt with granite edging on road entrance. This ties in with the road and landscape with majority of edging going into grass banks.		

Recommendation: to fund this project from the balance of the allotment EMR, amenities EMR and Haslemere Community Fund.
