

Rotary Club of Haslemere Talk to Me Counselling Monitoring Update

Firstly on behalf of the Counsellors and Team at The Haslewey we would like to thank you for your funding totalling £2500 and partnership in the project to date.

The initial discussions started in early 2021 with the set up of a suitable space for Counselling out of The Haslewey. The Covid-19 pandemic had identified a real need for affordable counselling and after discussions with yourselves we agreed to start the "Talk to Me" counselling service in partnership with the first face to face counselling starting in July.

Both our Counsellors (Fiona Hewkin & Bernadette Gibson) have seen clients and during September and October both were at capacity. Bernadette had to withdraw services during November & December due to personal circumstances but will be back at Haslewey from January. This is of particular importance to the project as Bernadette offers her counselling on a volunteer basis with the Haslewey just reimbursing her insurance costs. Having a volunteer counsellor doubles the amount of people we can help as the resources and funding we presently have do not cover 2 paid counsellors. Looking ahead if we lose Bernadette I feel there will be a need to look to employ another counsellor as the need is there.

The Haslewey has not claimed any room hire costs during this time and ideally is looking to cover one of the days and applying for funding independently. We have also allowed use of the room on an ad hoc basis in the evenings to support those unable to attend during working hours. This requires another staff member to be in the building as per our safeguarding policy but to date has not been problematic.

2022 does not see the need for these services diminishing and there is a very strong indication that there will be a surge in people needing support post Christmas. This is a normal pattern with money and relationship problems, added with the ever changing pandemic situation there is still a very great need to continue with the "Talk to Me" services. We are also very newly identified as a Referral Service for Haslemere Centre for Health and the Doctors here are also indicating a real need for a counselling service such as ours to continue.

I have attached a breakdown of our costs to date together with your funding and donations received through the service.

Thank you again for your continued support, we could not offer this service without your help with funding.
