### **Amenities committee fund**

### **Lion Green**

- Orchard – We have obtained quotes for the vegetation clearance and tree work. Letters have been sent to owners/occupiers of houses abutting the proposed orchard advising of work and giving them an opportunity to contact us if there are any queries or concerns. Nothing heard back.

### **Lion Green Playground**

- Zip wire surface – it classed as low risk from the play inspector's point of view. Play contractor has advised it has at about 18-24 months life in it. We will continue to monitor it after each play inspection and recommend that should it become a medium risk it will be brought back to the committee. At that stage the committee will be asked to confirm how it wishes to proceed. It may be that resurfacing it can be incorporated into works referred to at item 8 on the agenda.
- We are retaining £10,000 of the play equipment reserve, with the balance being put back into general reserves.
