## Clerk's report to Full Council 23rd September 2021

The inaugural **car boot sale** on Lion Green went really well, with many residents asking when the next one was happening. There were around 40 vehicles and it raised approximately £350.00 for the Mayor's charities.

The **Haslemere Unlocked** event on Lion Green on 29<sup>th</sup> August was very well attended, another great town event. Again, we have been asked several time if this could be done on alternate years when the Fringe is not on. This was a collaboration of HTC and local volunteers and showcased the fabulous local talent we have in the area.

**Arran** has unfortunately left us, we have made an offer of employment to his replacement and they should be staring on 4<sup>th</sup> October.

**Town team**. During the pandemic Haslemere Town Council brought together a group of stakeholders who were in contact with residents affected in different ways by Covid. We held regular meetings to work together to see how we could best serve our residents and, more importantly, how we could work together to best serve the town. The meetings turned out to be extremely valuable and our residents definitely benefited from the collaboration that occurred.

We are now looking to widen this and establish a local group which
