Household support fund – we have been inundated with calls. Not helped by the fact that half of the Waverley residents who should have received letters about it at the beginning of February didn't get them until last week We've helped approximately 80 families to the tune of £20,000.

Annual Town Meeting - provisional date is Wednesday 27th April – please put in your diaries.

Installation of bike shelters in High St car will happen from mid to late May. It is a wooden bike shelter, stained black with opaque roof and will take up approximately 3 car parking spaces.

Welcome Back Fund – another 10,000 recyclable coffee cups are on order to be distributed to retailers across the Council area. We are also hoping to get some more 'town beautification' works in before the 31st March deadline.

Code of Conduct training for members – this will be offered in person and virtually and the video will be available afterwards for those who cannot attend. Working on dates with WBC.
