

Please note, in all options thick black line denotes the proposed deer fence.  
In option 2, the broken black line denotes an alternative way of increasing the number of plots.

#### Option 1 - Deer fence around the existing allotment plots only



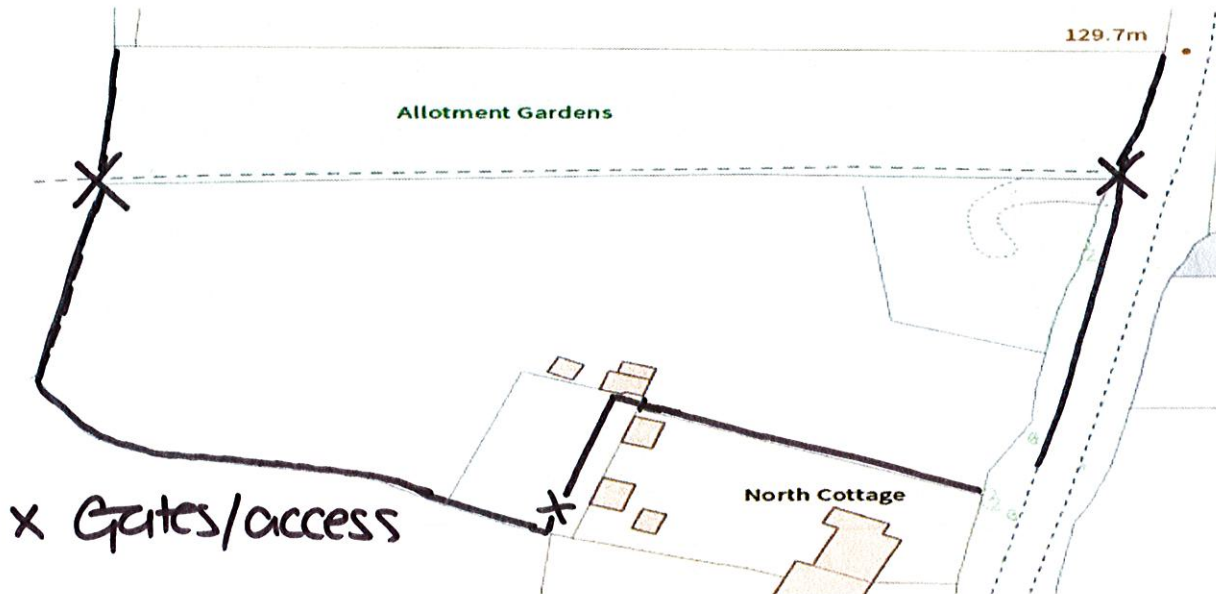
Pros	Cons
No requirement to replace the gates	No future proofing of the site as fencing would have to be moved if the Council sought to increase the number of plots

#### Option 2 – Deer fence around the existing allotment plots plus part of the grazing field



Pros	Cons
No requirement to replace the gates, allows for an increase in the number of plots	Any additional increase in the number of plots would require the fencing to be moved

### Option 3 – Deer fence around entire site



Pros	Cons
Site completely future proofed in order to increase the number of plot	Possible requirement to replace one or both gates at either end of the footpath, and provide a gate for North Cottage to access (they hire the grazing field and keep it mown).
