

Resurfacing of the zip wire runway

The Amenities Committee was asked by Finance & Governance last year to identify play equipment projects as reserves had not been spent. The projects that were undertaken were subsequently funded by S106 contributions paid by Waverley BC, leaving the reserves largely intact. The Committee is asked to reconsider the resurfacing of the zip wire runway with a bonded rubber mulch.

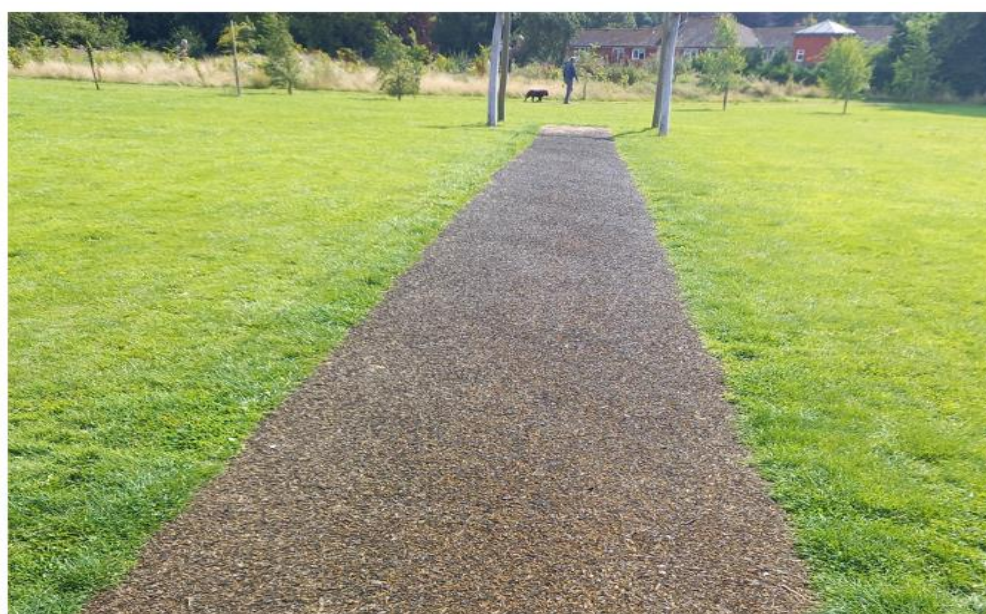


Image Easebourne Park zip wire surface
