Clubhouse Redevelopment

- Clubhouse has served us well but in need of repair and refurbishment. Stairs no longer meet B Regs.
- Redevelopment tricky (so expensive) – restricted by the position of trees and severely sloping site.
- Of the total project budget (now £100,000), £10,000 is earmarked for the development of our disabled facilities, including a modern toilet and 100% step-free access to the clubhouse via a new ramp
- Aspects of the project with a particular benefit to younger people include
 - Replacement and reorientation of the external staircase to comply with Building Regulations, will enable children to securely access the club's loo and facilities within sight of the coaches and without leaving the secure area.
 - Shelter when the weather turns bad during coaching sessions (current clubhouse too small)
 - A TV/video area to use as a coaching, learning, & analysis tool
- And of course more attractive for all current and potential adult & junior members too
 - Access to a larger clubhouse, with easy seating and coffee table for socialising
 - Larger kitchen area with more storage allowing more and better social functions
 - Extension at the front with increased glazing giving great views onto the courts
 - Improved decking area with more seating for players and parents to sit and spectate, and for social events
