QUOTE FOR WEB DEVELOPMENT: LOVE HASLEMERE HATE WASTE (LHHW)

AN OVERVIEW OF THE PROBLEM

Development of a web solution for online management and scheduling of requests and appointments to the new LHHW Repair Cafe. This is intended to be a long term infrastructure service for Haslemere and to reduce the amount of waste through recycling of existing items.

Due to strong take up LHHW currently has the problem of all repair requests coming through a single email account and this is creating a significant bottleneck. Community demand is high and this is proving impossible to handle the requests effectively.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To compel site visitors to use or book a service they offer
- 2. To make the site as easy to navigate as possible
- 3. To make the information available as easy to understand as possible
- 4. To increase further site visitors and traffic through the site
- 5. To minimise the loading times of each page

OUR SOLUTION SUGGESTIONS

- Development of a website solution (and perhaps additionally an iOS/android app) which enables repair cafe requests/bookings to be logged via the website/app and automatically directed to the relevant Repair Cafe operator for rapid and appropriate response (without resort to a "sorting" middleman).
- This would be done with requests being queued to each operator depending on type of repair.



- Operators would be set up with their skill sets entered for the system to know how to allocate jobs to the most appropriate person in priority order.
- The system would control the workflow and allow the customer to track the job though a selection of statuses, culminating in an automated response back to the customer when the item is ready for collection.
- Additionally a workflow management solution to automatically record and report the jobs as well as the benefits (# jobs, £ collected, CO2 saved etc) to track success of the initiative. Reporting would be provided for LHHW.
- Introduce a few warm colours and softer shapes into your digital style, without breaking brand guidelines. This will help a user feel more comfortable, welcomed and supported throughout the process. These can be scary and overwhelming life tasks, so to make the process as easy and approachable as possible will be welcomed by your audience.
