

## Haslemere Town Council Small Grant/Green Grant Application Form

### **Additional Information and Supporting Documents for Weyhill Montessori School**

#### Project Details:

*What aspect of the project will grant money be used for?*

The grant money will be put towards the purchase, installation and maintenance of a “Mindray C1A Semi-Automatic Defibrillator and External Heated Cabinet with Keypad Lock” for emergency first aid use by staff, parents or children attending Weyhill Montessori School at High Lane Community Centre, as well as the surrounding neighbourhood.

*What benefits for the Haslemere community do you expect will result from the project?*

As well as the regular attendees of Weyhill Montessori School, the defibrillator will also be available for use by all groups of the Girlguiding Haslemere Division, including Rainbows, Brownies, Guides and Rangers, who use the High Lane Community Centre as their base. As the proposed defibrillator will be housed outside the building, it will also be available to residents in the high-density housing estate surrounding the community centre, as well as staff, students and parents of the nearby St Bartholomew’s C of E Primary School and parishioners of St Bartholomew’s Church. The adjacent playing fields are regularly used by members of the local community for fitness sessions and ball games, and there is a playground that is also popular with families, who would also benefit should an emergency occur. Additionally, the community centre is available for hire by the public and is often used as a polling station.

#### Funding Details

*Have you or will you be applying to other bodies for financial assistance?*

The nursery will be purchasing the defibrillator and cabinet through a charity called London Hearts, who are offering a grant of £300 towards the purchase, as shown in the email below.

*What fundraising activities will your organisation be doing to fund this project?*

The nursery’s Parent Group, the “Friends of Weyhill Montessori School”, will be fundraising through activities such as coffee mornings, quiz nights and raffles. The children attending the nursery will also be doing a sponsored run on the field and asking their parents, carers and families to support them in raising funds for the cause.

### Organisation Details

*What are the aims and objectives of the organisation?*

Weyhill Montessori is a nursery school for children between the ages of 2½ and 5 years. Our aim is to provide the very best in pre-school education, giving children a happy start to school life and a solid foundation, in preparation for the next step. London Hearts is a charity and as such cannot charge for any products supplied but would ask that you donate to the minimum amount.

**We are currently able to offer an increased grant of £300 towards the cost of each Defibrillator we supply** and are also able to offer package deals.

The Defibrillator we supply is the new advanced dual functioning Mindray C1A semi-automatic Defibrillator. Not only does this model carry out daily self-diagnostic tests, meaning maintenance is extremely limited but more importantly this model can be applied to both an adult and a child at the flick of a switch rather than having to waste time changing the pads. I attach the Information leaflet on the Mindray C1A.

The usual cost for Mindray C1A Defibrillator is £1045.00 however taking into account our £300 donation, the required minimum donation for the Defibrillator alone is currently £745.00.

Mindray C1A Defibrillator & External heated Unlocked Cabinet £1225.00

**Mindray C1A Defibrillator & External heated Cabinet with keypad lock £1255.00**

VAT is not applicable therefore providing a further 20% saving to those who are not VAT registered.

Additional products include external & internal cabinets and internal wall brackets. I would advise that if a defibrillator is to be kept outside then it must be housed in a heated locked or unlocked heated cabinet with a 10 year warranty (usual minimum donation £495.00/£525.00) – it is entirely your preference as to whether you would like a locked or unlocked cabinet. If kept inside, then you do not require any other equipment however some people have preferences for it to be kept either in an indoor unlocked (with door alarm) or locked (key lock) cabinet (usual minimum donation £135.00 unlocked and £145.00 for locked) or on a wall hanger/bracket (usual minimum donation £85.00). The minimum donation figures do not apply as they have been reduced in the package offers above.

We do not install any products however the defibrillator itself does not require a power source (battery operated) but the external heated wall cabinet does – this being a standard 3 pin plug socket. There is no annual service charge and maintenance simply requires that the Defibrillator battery needs to be changed after 5 years at a cost of approximately £200.00 and the pads which have a 5 year life span from date of manufacture (3 year guarantee) need changing at either date of expiry or after each use (cost of approximately £45.00).

The Mindray C1A Defibrillator we supply comes with a 8 year Warranty.

As a charity we want to raise awareness regarding Defibrillators. We therefore offer a FREE online CPR & Defibrillator Awareness Training session with the defibrillators we supply.
