The application is for trading seven days a week between the hours of 10:00 and 19:00 from March – September only. As this is an itinerant trader, there is no fixed trading location and a condition will be added to any Consent granted limiting the amount of time that can be spent in any one location.

Recommendation: Haslemere Town Council objects to a Haslemere wide street trading permission and wishes to see a restriction placed that trading from the van is not to take place at any time from the following locations: Lion Lane, Wey Hill, West Street, High Street. Haslemere Town Council makes this objection in accordance with Waverley Street Trading policy 2021 section.2.5 in that it believes sufficient trading outlets serve the needs of the area.
