16/23 AMNESTY BENCH

After a short discussion, the committee voted to approve the installation of a brass plaque by the local Amnesty group on the bench outlined in their application in Town Meadow. As there were special circumstances (it was replacing the plaque associated with a tree in Town Meadow that had subsequently died and been felled), the committee approved the deviation from the memorial bench policy at point 8 of the specification, and were happy for the inscription outlined in the application.

RECOMMENDED: The Amnesty group can purchase and install the brass plaque as per their application.

17/23 GROUNDS MAINTENANCE ISSUES

The Deputy Town Clerk updated the committee as a second quote had been received, which was double that of the first quote. The Committee asked the clerk to check how environmentally friendly the anti-fungal growth inhibitor was to ensure using it sat comfortably with the Council's climate and biodiversity policy.
