Dear Town Council Members,

Thank you so much for taking the time to consider Haslemere Swimming Clubs application for a Small Grant. I thought it may be useful to send you some detailed information to try and demonstrate our goal and how we hope to achieve it. Please do not hesitate to contact me if I can share more information.

Haslemere Swimming Club is a wonderful, inclusive club that has been part of the local community for over 50 years. With swimmers from 3 years old to over 70 years old swimming every week, we pride ourselves on having a place for everyone. We run a Swimming Academy teaching over 122 swimmers, a competitive structure as well as an active masters programme.

The club welcomes a fantastic community of enthusiastic and motivated children, teenagers and adults from the local area. All our swimmers work exceptionally hard to be the best they can whatever their aspirations and are coached by an enthusiastic, motivated team who strive to help everybody reach their full potential.

Having never fundraised before, we are aiming to purchase essential, up to date, safe, equipment. Diving blocks are a fundamental part of training for competitive swimmers and are crucial to children at all levels of the developmental pathway. Our diving blocks have become worn, slippery and wobbly over the years and are not in line with current standards.

New diving blocks will be instrumental to our younger swimmers, enabling them to focus on improving their dive technique and subsequently their racing times. This year we have five swimmers competing in National events and the opportunity to fine tune their diving skills, on the proper equipment, in their home pool, would be immensely valuable.

Unfortunately, like so many other clubs, the pandemic hit HSC hard. We held regular zoom land based workouts, kept our swimmers engaged with quizzes and Q&A sessions but, with the pool closed, lost out on valuable revenue whilst supporting our coaches and teachers.

When we returned to the pool, our Swimming Academy and squads ran at reduced, socially distanced numbers and we were unable to hold any galas. Pool hire costs have increased and

are likely to continue to rise. We had saved hard as a club to be in the position to purchase these much needed blocks, we no longer are.

The club brings together children from many different schools and as they move through the pathway strong friendships and camaraderie develop. The children have wonderful sense of belonging and support each other in training, competition and out of the pool!

Fundraising has been an excellent way to bring our HSC community of parents and children back togther again after the reduced access over the pandemic. The children are doing 24hr Swimathons, cake sales, used book sales and a 'number plate, lights and screen wash' to support the cause. There is a wonderful buzz in our community.

This grant is only received if we reach our Crowdfunding goal of £18000 and have 100 unique supporters in our four-week target.

ASA Surrey - £3300

Surrey ASA have pledged approximately £3300. Again, this is only available to us if we raise the rest of the required money.

We are using our Club Champs Gala entrance fee, cake sales, used book sales, reward based donating and other mini events by groups of swimmers to keep working towards our total. The entire swim club is working hard together.

We have made applications for sponsorship to a number of local businesses and schools, however it is challenging times for many businesses. We have approached the Shottermill Great War Memorial Trust and the Haslmere Roatary.


