#### Camelsdale facilities project 2022-23 season

- New roll on, roll off goal posts. Funded by FA grant
- Pitch maintenance. Funded by FA grant.
- Extension to the patio area outside the pavilion. Applying for Green/Small Grant from Haslemere Town Council.
- Extend car park. Fundraising.

### Why Haslemere Town Council?

We have previously requested a grant from Lynchmere Parish Council for the extension to the patio area however they have no available funds to support us.

Our club is called Haslemere Town Youth Football Club and our registered club address (14 Trout Road GU27 1RD) is within the Haslemere Town Council borders.

Furthermore, the majority of our players and their parents reside within the Haslemere Town Council borders.

Camelsdale Recreation Ground is the best available local location for youth football up to the age of 12.

#### Patio Proposal

We would like to double the size of the patio area in front of the pavilion from 3 rows of 60cm x 60cm paving slabs to 6 rows of 60cm x 60 cm paving slabs. The area in front of the pavilion becomes very boggy in the autumn and winter and extending the patio area would enable us to place tables, chairs, and a gazebo on firm ground.

This will hopefully encourage more people to use our café and hence generate more income for our not for profit community football club which is run solely by parent volunteers.

It should also mean less mud will be trodden into the pavilion and therefore less time, materials and money will be spent on cleaning the pavilion.

#### Green initiatives

We run a plastic free café. We only use reusable china mugs for tea and coffee. Any leftover food from the café is taken home and used by members of the club. We do not throw any food away.

We run a boot bank/boot swap at Camelsdale whereby children donate boots they have grown out of which they can then exchange for a bigger pair of second hand boots deposited by a different Haslemere player.

We are proposing to work with Haslemere Active Travel to encourage parents of the club to either cycle or walk to home matches with their children. We Would like to cordon off a safe area for bikes to be stowed whilst the football takes place.

We actively encourage our parents and children to car share where possible for away fixtures.
