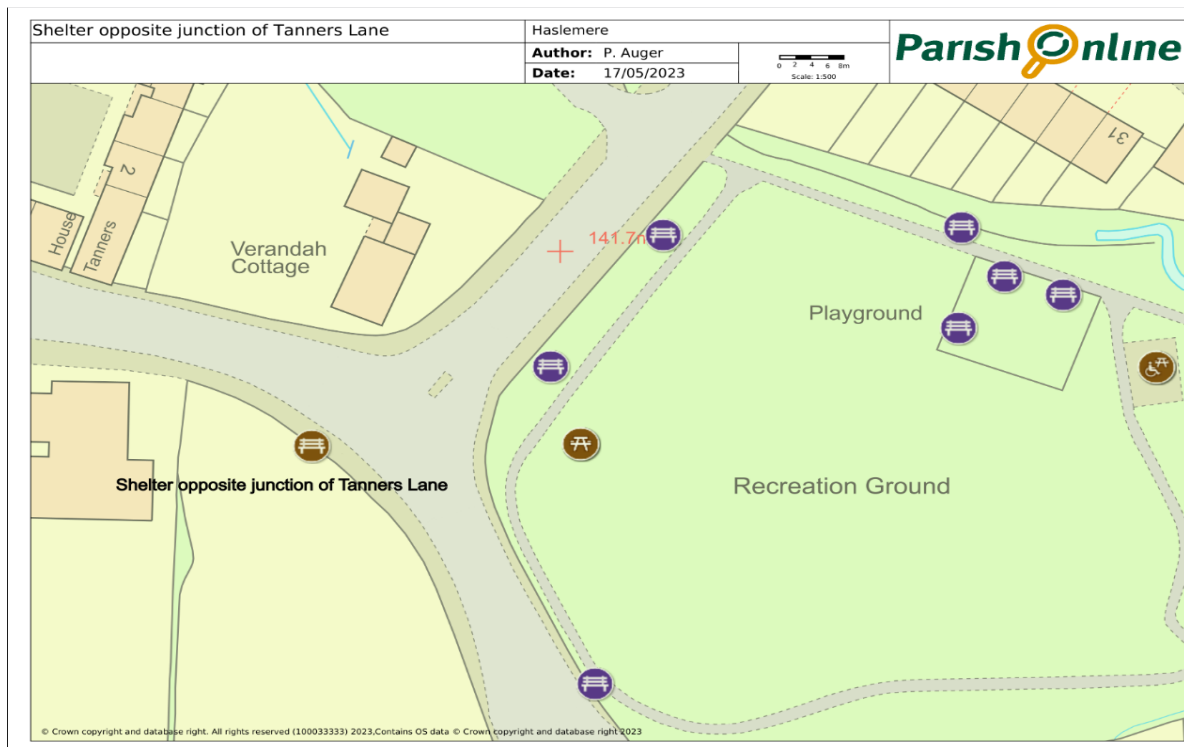
SHELTER OPPOSITE JUNCTION OF TANNERS LANE

BACKGROUND

- There is no formal record about ownership of this shelter and bench seat (see map below for location), with the exception of a plaque (shown below).
- Council has recently paid for the old bench seat to be replaced following complaints from local residents.
- There are now minor issues with the roof leaking, requiring some roof felting, which Martin can do.

RECOMMENDATION: The shelter and bench be added to the Council's asset register so that it can assume responsibility for it.

RECOMMENDATION: Repairs to the roof to be paid for out of the Amenities budget if any additional roofing material is required.
