Resolution: Tilford Road Traffic Calming

Noting the deterioration in the existing speed calming scheme along Tilford Road in Hindhead, the lack of physical speed calming measures at the blind junction between Tilford Road and Wood Road, and the considerable pedestrian traffic across the Tilford Road in this vicinity to the community hall (at the rear of St. Alban's Church), Haslemere Town Council asks Surrey County Council:

- 1. To refurbish the existing speed calming measures to a standard equivalent to when they were first implemented to restore their effectiveness.
- 2. To provide physical speed calming (e.g. a speed hump) on the Tilford Road before the junction with Wood Road in the Farnham direction of travel to better protect traffic exiting Wood Road.
- 3. To investigate the possibility of providing a pedestrian crossing of the Tilford Road in the vicinity of the community hall at the rear of St. Alban's Church.
