The CIL regulations (Reg. 59F) require that the Neighbourhood CIL must be spent on: a) the provision, improvement, replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure; or b) anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on an area.

Under s121B of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2019 the Council is required to prepare a report and publish it on it's website and Waverley Borough Council's website no later than 31 December following the reported year.
