What benefits for the Haslemere community do you expect will result from the project? ³	The two benefits we are expecting to achieve for the Haslemere Community are to reduce food waste (specifically in order to reduce volume of methane gas produced by rotting food, and to reduce cost to families), and to redistribute food to those who need it most.. The project will be run by local volunteers so we also expect a side benefit to be encouraging involvement in the community.
