

## Haslemere North Ward.

Having walked around our ward these are the following items that we have so far noticed need doing.

- 1) Overgrown hedges and bushes which are causing obstructions onto the high way at the top of High Lane towards the junction of Weydown Road.
- 2) Dog poo bins to be positioned on the entrances to Whispers Wood to encourage dog walkers to pick up the dog poo.
- 3) Pavement down Chatsworth avenue, The steep bit of the hill where people are regularly tripping on the uneven path
- 4) Public Footpath going from The Spinney to Church Lane alongside the railway line. Overgrown on both sides of the path and uneven footpath due to roots from trees etc. Its is currently not possible to push wheelchairs or prams down this path due to risk of injury
- 5) High Lane shop – Possible light pollution at night due to its floodlighting lights which look similar to those seen at stadiums. The opposite park and houses over 250 meters away are lit up, so much so that a resident living down playing field close has had to install black out blinds.
- 6) The cleaning of all road signs and weeding around the polls.
- 7) All benches in the ward need to be weather treated as these are looking weather battered including Grayswood playing field/Cricket pitch.
- 8) Bins on the playing field by Parsons green to be replaced.
- 9) Reminder speed limit signage on the main road A286 going through Grayswood the 30mph zone.
- 10) Children's play area in the park by Parsons Green/ Playing Field Close needs some tender love and care.
