The local health centre and the Fountain Centre will print out posters for free. £1100 fee of the training of two Green and Blue instructors. Hi Jo,

In answer to your questions:-

1 - The classes started last week with 3 cancer patients, and we have had already 3 more referred this week. As the cancer fitness class can only accommodate 5 patients at a time, we are opening a second session and also spinning class for up to 8 patients. With the two new trainers we could open up more classes and spinning sessions. We are sure we are going to get lots more referrals as we have not yet started to advertise in the community yet. We also have plans to open up classes for children in the future.

2 - Yes the classes are aimed to local residents. If we find that we have residents from outside Haslemere we are planning to approach their local councils for funding of classes rather than training.

As an update, we have started a justgiving page to cover over 20 classes and we have almost reached the target.
