Wreath Laying Order

- Mayor and VIP's
- Representatives of regular forces
- Representatives of territorial and reserve forces
- Representatives of ex-Service associations, including RBL & RBLWS
- Representatives of uniformed public services (police, fire brigade, ambulance services)
- Other tiers of local government (Waverley, Surrey etc).
- Representatives of uniformed voluntary services (St John, Red Cross etc)
- Representatives of cadet forces
- Representatives of youth organisations
- Other organisations and members of the public

There is no need to rush to lay your wreath. There will be plenty of time for everyone to perform this important role while the Mayor reads out the names of the fallen.
