3/25 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

4/25 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE LAST MINUTES

The Chair gave an update on Earth Day. This is a great initiative but wasn't well attended last year. HTC is working with the Museum and other partners to have a better turn out this year.

Actions:

Clerk to circulate a flyer with details for members to share with their networks.

Cllr Matthes to chase Kay Topping for small grant application.

5/25 GREEN GRANT – ST BARTHOLOMEW'S SCHOOL PTA (£596.40)

The committee considered the grant for items for new allotment and gardening area. It was noted that some of the equipment looked expensive, and that the PTA is not looking for funding elsewhere. HTC does not normally fund 100% of project costs. This is a valuable project, but the committee had some questions / feedback for the applicant:

- What is going to happen to the produce when grown?
- Can we see evidence of what is produced?
- HTC needs to be mentioned in promotional material.

RESOLVED: That a grant of £500 is awarded to St Bartholomew's School PTA for items for their new allotment and gardening area.

This award still leaved £3500 in the Green Grants pot for this financial year. Further applications could be taken to March full council if received in time. Cllrs to encourage their networks to apply.

6/25 <u>COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT – BRIEF UPDATES</u>

Cllr Matthes gave an update on the successful Wassail at Swan Barn farm.

There was some discussion over the possible implications of new Planning regulations the government is bringing in.
