

## LGR Working Party (LGRWP) Meeting 10am 13<sup>th</sup> August 2025

## Note of meeting

Cllr Carter welcomed those present and reported that now outline costs for any asset transfers have been received, it is probable that council will not be able to take on everything it had identified in its initial 'wish list'. On that basis he, Cllr Keen and the Clerk had done an initial review and prioritised the asset transfers on the basis of community value, vulnerability to loss or neglect etc.

Cllr Carter explained that, although the War Memorial Recreation Ground had been on the Council's list for some time, it was at low risk of loss to the community due to its war memorial and Fields in Trust status and would potentially be costly to quire due to the complexities added with leaseholders and more than one land registry title.

The working party considered the land transfers being proposed and the following points were made:

Residents need to be able to understand why the council is spending money on these asset transfers, bearing in mind the potential cost.

We need to be mindful that although the new Unitary authority may well want to divest itself of some local assets after it comes into being in 2027, they equally may not want to engage with the council so we need to secure key assets for our residents now.

The war memorial recreation ground is a key asset for the town and is due to be considered for transfer by the Waverley Executive in October, along with the BH recreation ground and High St public toilets. These transfers should go ahead as agreed by full council.

The costs quoted by Waverley, especially for external valuations, seem very high. The Clerk to approach them and ask them to reconsider.

The George Denyer pavilion is not on the priority list but it is recognised that the building is of potential use to community groups such as Love Haslemere Hate Waste.

In terms of open / common land more work needs to be done. It may well be that the council doesn't have to take on the freeholds, ClIr Bridge thought there might be a mechanism whereby we can secure stewardship without having the obligations of ownership.

Haslemere Biodiversity Group could add value by assessing the pieces of land for their environmental value to the town.

A site visit needs to be made to these open spaces identified, this may best be done on a weekend when most people will be available.

The Clerk is meeting with the council's groundscare contractors next week to get some idea of costs for ongoing maintenance for the sites identified.

## It was RECOMMENDED that:

The Clerk will pay the initial Waverley fees for the transfers of the three sites which have so far been applied for – Haslemere War Memorial recreation ground, Beacon Hill recreation ground and High St public toilets.

In the Winter newsletter, which goes to all residents, there will be a report on LGR proposed asset transfers and residents will be given the opportunity to make comments back on the proposals.

The Clerk and Cllr Bridge will come up with a route for the site visit to take place on a Saturday late September / early October. All councillors and Haslemere Biodiversity Group will be invited to attend.

HTC will support any move by LHHW or Haslemere Community Land Trust to take over the George Denyer pavilion.
